SSESA Visiting Fellow Award -2015

Boston based Aligarh Alumni Association (Aligarh Alumni Association of New England-AAANE) in collaboration with Aligarh Muslim University invites applications for "SSESA Visiting Fellow Award-2015". The award is limited to current AMU faculty and support short term visits to the US universities to initiate joint research projects. Based on the project status and mutual interest the collaboration may continue at AMU after the return of the faculty. The award will provide J-1 visa, return air fare, health insurance and a stipend for three months. The subject areas will depend on the availability of funds, laboratory space, visa sponsorships and mutual interest of both parties.
